

Dear Parents/Guardians and campers,

We ask that you read the following CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT. This will ensure that, should your group leader(s) and/or Sherbrooke Lake Camp Staff find it necessary to send a camper home, everyone concerned will be aware of the particular part of the CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT that was broken.

Sherbrooke Lake Camp would like to reassure you that sending a camper home would be a final measure - after all other means of dealing with the problem have failed.

CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Once campers are assigned to their cabins, entering the other cabins will be prohibited.
2. Sherbrooke Lake is a tobacco, alcohol and drug free facility. All of those items will be confiscated and the camper will be sent home.
3. No camper is to handle medication. All medications should be labeled with all instructions to the organizations group leader and they will administer the medications. Sherbrooke Lake Camp will not be responsible for administering medications.
4. No profanity.
5. No graffiti, etc. Parents/guardians will be required to pay for any intentional damages caused by their son/daughter.
6. A curfew will be set with the group leaders and Sherbrooke Lake Camp. Once the curfew is set, failure to follow curfew may result in a request for parents/guardian to pick up camper.
7. Campers are not to be at the waterfront at any time without waterfront staff.
8. Campers are to respect the privacy of others at all times. Pictures of a sensitive nature are not to be taken of people and are definitely not to be shared by e-mail, text or on social media sites.
9. Campers are to wear closed shoes when asked and are to always have foot wear on, except on the beach.
10. Campers are to participate in activities and duties unless excused by the Director.
11. Campers are responsible for their belongings and are to treat other campers and their belongings with respect.
12. Cell phones or other electronics are not permitted outside of the cabin. Any brought will be confiscated and returned on the last day.
13. Overall camper supervision is the responsibility of your group leaders. However some Sherbrooke Lake Camp staff will assist in this regard. However, if behavioural issues become apparent with the campers it will be up to your group leaders to deal with them in accordance with their policies &/or procedures
14. Campers will follow the Sherbrooke Lake Camp policies and procedures manual if situations arise emergency situations arise.
